- work in Austria, Germany or the Netherlands

We want to know, which factors influence your work, how your work affects your mental wellbeing, if there are any challenges in doing your work and how you overcome these challenges.

This survey also includes questions on experiences of stigmatization and violence. <u>Answering</u> these questions is not mandatory.

How is my personal data protected?

Your data is of course confidential and will only be used for scientific purposes. Your data will be **processed anonymously** and only analysed at group level. Demographic data such as age or gender do not allow any clear conclusions to be drawn about your person. We do not collect any technical data (e.g. IP address, device type or similar).
